Nominating Procedure

Please submit the following to make a nomination **by June 1:**

- A one- to two-page letter nominating the person. The letter may be signed by one or more individuals and should outline the major reasons why the nominee should receive the award.
- A biographical statement on the nominee. This statement should include career history, family information, educational background, civic and volunteer service.

The awards are presented annually at the President's Circle Dinner. In the case of scheduling conflicts, awards can be presented at a mutually agreeable time at an appropriate ceremony at Woodward Academy.
