

International Language Certification Exams

SPANISH DELE (Diplomas of Spanish as a Foreign Language)

The official accreditation of the degree of fluency of the Spanish language, the DELE is issued and recognized by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport of Spain.

FRENCH DELF (Dîplome d'Etude en Langue Française)

The DELF is the official qualification awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates from outside France in the French Language. The DELF is composed of six independent diplomas that correspond to the levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The exam is required of foreign nationals enrolling in French Universities. Candidates can register for the examination of their choice, according to their level.

GERMAN Goethe Zertifikat

The Goethe-Institut's German language examinations correspond to the levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and range from A1 for beginners to C2 for language skills at the highest level.

Japanese JLPT

JLPT certificates offer various advantages, ranging from recognition as academic credit and graduation certification at schools to preferential treatment at companies and acknowledgement of qualification in society.

CHINESE HSK (The Chinese Proficiency Test)

The HSK is China's national standardized test designed and developed by the HSK Center of Beijing Language and Culture University to assess the Chinese Language proficiency of non-native speakers (including foreigners, overseas Chinese and students from Chinese national minorities).
